Session 2018-19

1) In the first meeting of the cell held on 29-09-2018 (Saturday) the committee decided to organize one day workshop on Interview Technique. The passout students as well as undergraduate students were informed about the workshop and Prof. Niraj P. Kendhe was invited as a resource person.

On 29-09-2018 the cell organized One day workshop on Interview Techniques. Prof. Niraj P. Kendhe informed the students about various techniques to face the job interview. PPT and lecture method used by the resource person made the workshop interesting Principal Dr. H.R. Verulkar and Mr. Sandip Kale also delivered speech on soft skills, self employment and

presentation skills. mMre than 100 students were enlightened through this workshop. Prof. Anup Gumble, Dr. Pawan B. Thakre, Dr. S.A.Pande organized the workshop.



2) One Day Workshop on Skill Development and Self Employment:

Career counseling and Placement Cell in collaboration with *Panchayat Samiti*, Arvi organized one day workshop on 1st Feb 2019. Government's various welfare schemes for the youths and employment. The cell aims to provide this information to the beneficiaries. Mr.K.B.Hadve Campaign Manager, MSRLM and Mr.R.B.Chopde, Extension Officer, *Panchayat Samiti*, Arvi. Distt:Wardha were invited as a trainer. Mr. Hadve informed the students about **Pt. Din Dayal Upadhyay Gramin Koushalya Vikas Yojana**, *National Rural Jivan Jyoti Abiyan* and *Asmita Yojana*. DDUGKY provides free training to the students for 3 months and guarantees 100% placement. More than 200 students were benefitted by this workshop. . Prof.Dr. Anup Gumble, Dr. Pawan B. Thakre, Dr V. Y. Meley, Dr. S. V. Bhuyar Dr. S.A.Pande organized the workshop.

Dr.H.R.Verulkar precided over the workshop, Prof Dharmesh Raut, Deputy Speaker, Panchayat Samiti, Arvi was the Chief Guest. Students are informed to register for the training on 13th Feb. 2019 between 3 to 5 p.m.



3) On 5th March 2019 Tuesday one day workshop was organized by the cell. 22 parents and 40 + students attended the workshop in which the coordinator, Dr.A.V.Gumble, Dr Thakare, Mr Sanjay Meshram, Dr. S.A.Pande and Dr. S.V. Bhuyar convinced and encouraged the students to seek admission at the residential training programme at **Dhatri Foundation**, **Buttibori**, Nagpur. In this training students are trained for **Hospitality management**. Prof Dharmesh Raut informed the students and parents about traditional education/degrees and importance of professional skills and its development 17 Girls were admitted and completed their traing from 27 march to 27 June 2019. These girls are placed for jobs at Nagpur, Hyderabed etc in June 2019.



4) On 28th Feb 2019 Thusday the cell organized one day orientation Programme for students Mr. Prakash Kalamkar (Soft skill Trainer) and sonu Mandhare (B.Po.Trainer) of Dhatri Foundation, Battibori, Nagpur gave detailed information about Dhatri Foundation Training Programme. The training is only for Girls below poverty line, members of SHG, Job Card Holder of MNREGA. Trained Girl students will get 100% placement in Hotels, Companies, Showrooms and Molls.



5) On 28th March 2019, the cell organized one day placement camp by BEISMER SOLUITIONS, Wardha. 32 Students appeared for the DTP test and 20 students passed it. Mr. Pranav Thakre and Mr. Abhay Choudhary gave information about PMKY 2.0 as well as sales and Negotiable Skills, Banking, Stock Market, Data Entry, Marketing, Insurance and Accounting. The college proposes to start few short term courses in the session 2019-20.



6) 14 Feb. 2019 to 20 Feb. 2019

The cell invited and collected applications of students final year students for the post of security guard at Aero drum, Nagpur. 21 Applications are received and the students will be informed to appear for the recruitment camp for Wardha district to be held in the session 2019-20.



7) SHREYAS(Scheme for Higher Education youth for Apprenticeship and Skills)

The career counseling and placement cell informed the final year students about the Apprenticeship Programme. 40 Students are enrolled for this scheme.
