Guest Lecture

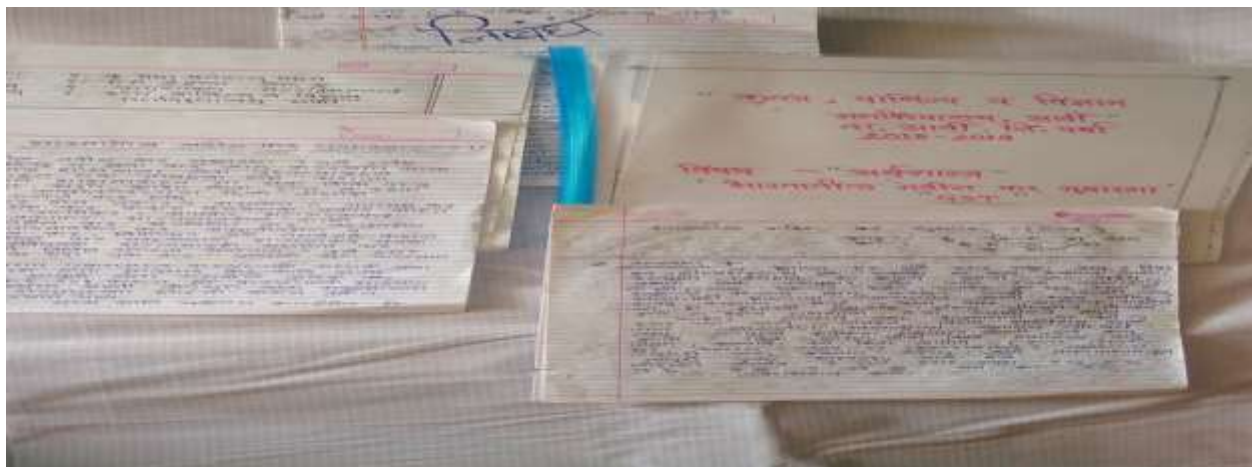

Observation of world Disability Day

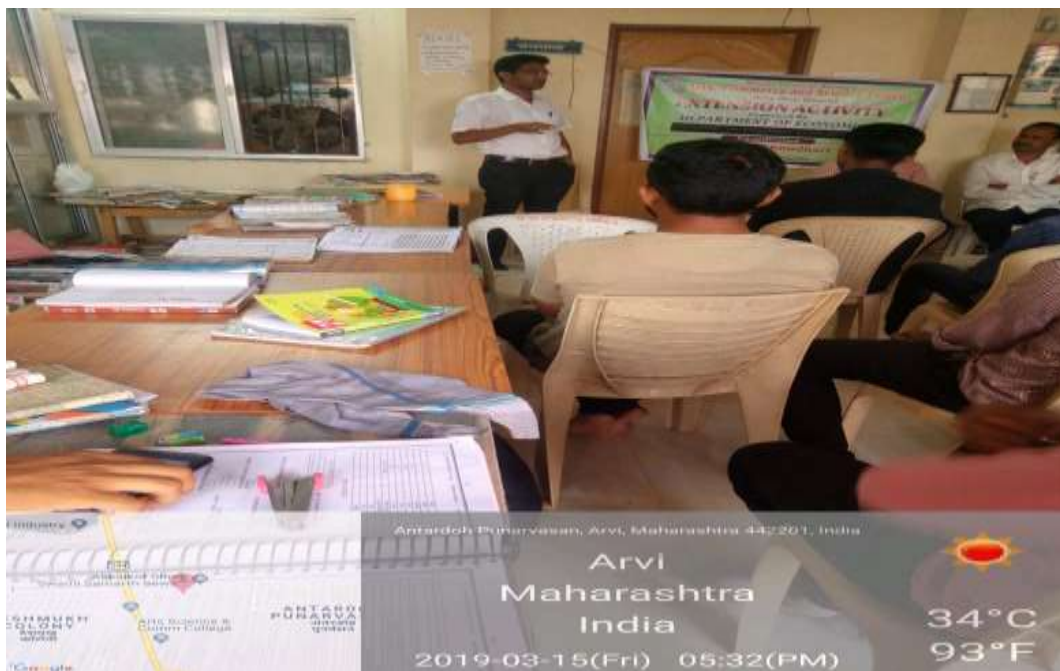
